AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 14, SECTION 14.3 – LAND BANK BOARD OF TRUSTEES: APPOINTMENT, TERMS: DISSOLUTION - OF THE FORT SCOTT MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING THE FORT SCOTT LAND BANK, AND DETERMINING THE MEMBERSHIP, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FORT SCOTT LAND BANK.


Sec. 14.3. Land Bank Board of Trustees: Appointment: Terms: Dissolution

- a. There is hereby established a Land Bank Board of Trustees. The Board shall be composed of seven (7) members. One Board member will be a representative of the City of Fort Scott City Commission. One member will be appointed by the Bourbon County Board of Commissioners. One member will be appointed by the Bourbon County Regional Economic Development Inc. Board of Directors. The remaining four (4) positions will be appointed by the Fort Scott City Commission and will include the following professions: one individual who represents banking with a term of three (3) years; one individual who represents developers with a term of two (2) years; one individuals who represents real estate with a term of two (2) years; and one member at large of the community with a term of one (1) year. These specified positions are recommended but not mandatory.
- b. Primary support the Board will come from the Economic Development Director of Bourbon County Regional Economic Development, Inc. and staff.
- c. The bank may be dissolved by Ordinance of the Governing Body, without cause. In such case, all property of the bank shall be transferred to and held by the City and may be disposed of as otherwise provided by law.

Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication of the Ordinance in the official City newspaper.
